

Alder Grove Onsite Classes

Registration: All students must turn in an enrollment form, emergency card, and discipline policy before attending classes. Please mail, drop off, or fax forms for each student to Alder Grove Charter School. Extra forms are available on our website. Emergency cards and discipline policies will also be available at the classroom site. Classes fill up on a first-come-first-served basis. If there are less than 6 students enrolled in a class it may be cancelled. M/W classes will keep a waiting list for students who enroll after a class has reached 12 students. If your child is on a waiting list you will be notified.

Fees:

Monday, Wednesday, and Friday Classes: \$65 per class each semester (taken out of the student's budget per semester)

Tuesday and Thursday classes: \$70 per one day a week class, \$130 per two days a week classes (taken out of the student's budget per semester).

*** Academic Support classes, Study Hall and Math/Language Arts labs are free of charge.**

Dropping a class: Classes may be dropped at any time in the first two weeks after classes start. Any student who drops after this time will be charged the full class price for the semester.

Please fill out a drop form in order to make sure records are accurate.

Adding a class: Any student adding a class after classes begin will need to communicate with their CT in order to see if there is space. Please do not add a class without approval.
