Hello Alder Grove Students and Families.

Thank you so much to those of you who could attend the Interimpalooza test prep event in February. The turnout was impressive and students had a great time! We have another Interimpalooza scheduled for March 10th, which will also feature a pizza lunch and prizes. Students who attend will feel prepared for the CAASPP when it happens in April, and more detailed test results will help you understand which concepts your student has mastered and which still need work. Talk to your CT if you would like to attend!

CAASPP (Smarter Balanced) testing will happen April 23-27. On-campus classes will be cancelled during that week. Make-up tests will happen the following week, April 30th - May 4th. Your teacher will let you know when your 3rd-8th, and 11th grade student(s) can sign up for times to take this state mandated assessment. All seniors and select 11th grade students will be required to take the CAST (science) assessment this year. Check with your CT for more information.

I can't believe we only have three more months until the end of the school year! Students, families, teachers, and staff look forward to this time every year, where all of our cooperative hard work pays off! Graduating seniors, please return your completed graduation information forms so we can order caps and gowns. Thank you for choosing Alder Grove Charter School to complete your high school education.

And finally, on February 22nd, the South Bay Unified School District board approved our new charter petition. This decision will continue our almost 12-year, positive relationship with the district. April 23 - 27th 2018

This is a fun, low-pressure way for students to get firsthand experience with the types of questions and technology they will encounter on the CAASPP.

Furthermore, Interim results are highly detailed, giving parents and teachers results that can inform instruction over the next few months!

You will get to eat pizza and win fun prizes. There will be door prizes for all students who attend! Please sign up with your CT.

Testing Schedule: Mark Your Calendars!!

Hello Students and Families,

April is approaching fast, and with that comes state mandated testing. As you know, California takes testing seriously, so we must test *all of our eligible students*. *Please mark your calendars with the following dates*.

April 23-April 27: CAASPP (Smarter Balanced) testing will take place from April 23-April 27. Students in 3rd through 8th grades, along with 11th graders, will be tested in Mathematics and Language Arts. Your CT will let you know when you can sign up for morning and/or afternoon testing slots during that week. Your CT can discuss with you the length of time necessary for each student to complete all sections of the test. *There will be NO ON-CAMPUS CLASSES during this testing week.*

April 30 and May 2: In addition, the California Science Test (CAST) field testing will take place April 30 and May 2. All students in 5th, 8th, **and 12th grades** should schedule a morning or afternoon time slot on one of these days. **Selected 11th graders will also be asked to take the CAST.** This is a computer-based assessment, and should take approximately 1-2 hours. *On-campus classes will resume this week.*

The California Physical Fitness Test (PFT) is also coming up for 5th, 7th, and 9th grade students. The test involves 6 quick strength and flexibility activities, including a timed one-mile walk/run. Contact your CT to get a form or to ask any questions you might have about completing the PFT. Forms, along with links to instructional videos, are also available on the Alder Grove website. *These forms will be due NO LATER than May 17th*.

Thank you in advance for helping us achieve 100% participation in mandated state testing!

REMINDER: A link to the CAASPP and CAST practice tests is available on the Alder Grove website. Also, there is still time to sign your student up for Interimpalooza on March 10. Your student can practice for the CAASPP and win prizes for participating! Talk to your CT if you have any questions about the practice tests.



Aurora Pitts came in 2nd place at the Regional Spelling Bee for the 4th-6th grade level.


