



When you feel overwhelmed and stressed, it can be hard to help your child feel balanced. 












College of the Redwoods Registration for High School Students Opens May 3

Students who have taken CR classes before just need a new <u>Concurrent Enrollment Form</u> for 2022-2023 and return via scan or in person to <u>jen.burtram@aldergrovecharter.org</u>. These forms must be PROCESSED by CR before students can register. This form can be sent via Adobe Sign upon request.

If students HAVEN'T taken a CR class before (concurrent or dual) they MUST complete a <u>CR Application</u>, as well. Pro Tip: Make sure they have or know their SSN before starting the application.

Students taking DUAL ENROLLMENT or CR WORK EXPERIENCE do not register via WEBADVISOR. They register via ALDER GROVE on campus registration and will complete ADD CARDS the first week of class with the onsite course instructor.

Students who are graduating high school and will be taking CR classes next year need to complete this <u>HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION FORM</u> and return to <u>ambassador@redwoods.edu</u> in order to register for more than 11 units at CR.
