
This year's graduation will be on Thursday, May 26, 2023.

ATTENTION SENIORS!

The <u>FAFSA</u> FREE Application for Federal Student Aid opens October 1.

These first come, first served funds that you do not have to pay back is your ticket to reduced university costs, as well as the TWO free years of community college.

Students who graduate from a California high school and meet certain income and GPA requirements are also eligible for the <u>CAL</u> <u>GRANT</u> which is additional money that can be used for college/training including books, computers, etc. The FAFSA is also used mandatory for many scholarships!

Please welcome our Student Success Coach, Yasmin, who is joining us this year to assist our seniors in completing the <u>FAFSA</u>! They might be calling you soon to set up a time to chat about your future plans and help you complete this important application.

PBIS UPDATE


Dear Alder Grove community,

PBIS BOOK OF THE MONTH: DECEMBER



book for Teens, you'll learn simple skills you can use to confidently handle school, make and keep friends, and organize and finish every project you start.


